Health District Out of Seasonal Flu Vaccine

With the exception of contracts with worksites, the Miami County Health District is out of seasonal flu vaccine for adults. Seasonal flu shots are still available at Kroger, Walgreens, CVS, Clark's pharmacies and many doctors' offices.

The health district still has a limited supply of vaccine for children ages 6 months to 35 months. This vaccine is in the form of shots as the supply of Flumist has been exhausted. Please call 440-5420 before coming out to see if the vaccine is still available.

"We will now be concentrating our efforts on the H1N1 clinics," according to James A. Luken, Miami County Health Commissioner. Look for them to start towards the end of October. Open clinics will be held at the old Steve and Barry's store at the Piqua Mall. "At this time, we have no H1N1 vaccine. An announcement will be made as soon as we receive it," states Luken.
