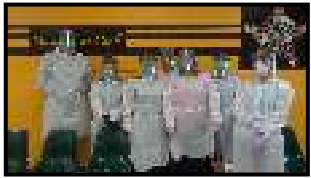
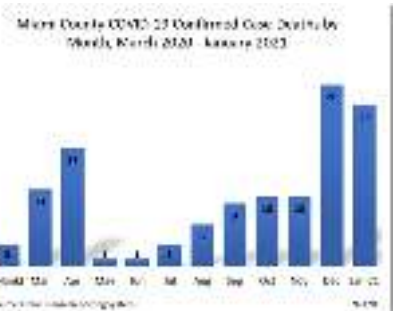

The theme focused on the impact of infant feeding on the environment and the importance of protecting, promoting, and supporting breastfeeding for the health of the planet and its people.

# NURSING DIVISION

The Nursing Division started out 2020 busy with our Immunization, Reproductive Health and Wellness, Well Child and Prenatal Safety-Net Clinics, as well as working with the many other programs we oversee such as Children with Medical Handicaps, Communicable Disease Reporting, TB, elevated blood Lead level follow-up, Help Me Grow and various other programs. In March we were suddenly cancelling our clinics, working from home, and entering hundreds of COVID test results into the Ohio Disease Reporting System (ODRS). We had to contact everyone with a positive test result to find out about symptoms and contacts. COVID testing was completed in nursing homes and at the county jail by our nurses as well. Our Reproductive Health Program learned how to do Telemedicine in an effort to decrease the number of people coming into the MCPH office. For months we had to stop giving immunizations and providing other clinic services due to COVID-19. The Help Me Grow (HMG) Home Visiting Team has still been busy serving families enrolled in our program. In March, when COVID hit, we had to adapt our program to continue seeing our families virtually, however we continued to make drop-offs to our families to ensure they have supplies and information. In 2020 the HMG program made 699 home visits.
