Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

Miami County - Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 in Miami County.

Over the past week, from May 30, 2020-June 5, 2020, Miami County has had 12 new COVID-19 cases and 2 new hospitalizations. This brings the total number of COVID-19 cases for Miami County to 367.

Beginning June 10th, under the Responsible Restart Ohio, entertainment venues like zoos, museums, playgrounds and aquariums, among others, can reopen as long as they follow proper safety guideline. With these additional openings there will be more opportunities to interact with others, so it is important to be cautious and help slow the spread of the virus. Stay home if you are sick, avoid those who are sick, practice safe social distancing and wear a face covering where social distancing is challenging.
