## Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

**Miami County –** Today, June 29, Miami County is reporting 13 new COVID-19 cases, 1 new hospitalizations and 1 new death since Friday, June 26, 2020. This brings the total number of COVID-19 cases for Miami County to 431 with 57 hospitalizations and 31 deaths.

Many states are reporting increased COVID-19 cases, especially in the age group for those 20-29. Miami County is also seeing an increase in positive COVID-19 cases for this age group. So far in the month of June, Miami County has seen the number of cases for this age group more than double. While persons in this age group may have less severe symptoms, they still have the ability to spread the virus to others and those who are more vulnerable. MCPH would like to remind everyone about the importance of best safety practices. Be cautious, limit social gatherings, practice safe social distancing of at least 6 feet and wear a mask/face covering to help limit the spread of the virus. Most importantly, if you are sick or if someone in your home is sick, please stay home and do not attend social gatherings.

MCPH will continue to work to keep the community safe and informed as COVID-19 situation evolves in Miami County.
