Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

Miami County - Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 in Miami County.

As of today, Monday, May 11, 2020, Miami County is reporting 313 positive COVID-19 cases and 28 deaths due to COVID-19, in Miami County. With the increase in testing, throughout Ohio and the Miami County, it is important that the community remember that this increase in positive COVID-19 cases is expected and does not indicate a sudden increase in the spread of the virus.

The Responsible Restart Ohio continues this week with additional businesses set to begin the reopening process. With safety precautions in place, on May 12th retail businesses will open, May 15th personal care services and outdoor dining at restaurants/bars will open, followed by indoor dining on May 21st.

“In the coming weeks, as we continue moving forward with reopening businesses there will be more people interacting. This reduction in restrictions is not the time to stop taking safety precautions. It’s important to be diligent in social distancing and wearing a mask or face covering to help protect yourself and others to help stop the spread of the virus.” Dennis Propes, Miami County Health Commissioner.
