Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

Miami County - Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 in Miami County.

As of today, Friday, March 27, 2020 it was confirmed that the 2 deaths from Koester Pavilion, with pending tests, were COVID -19 related. This brings the total confirmed deaths, due to COVID-19, to 4. Ohio Department of Health is reporting 32 positive cases in Miami County.

In the coming days and weeks, Miami County will continue to see an increase in positive COVID-19 cases associated with community spread. This is expected and serves as a reminder that everyone in the community should be following the Stay-At-Home order. By staying at home and practicing social distancing, that will slow the spread of the virus and will help flatten the curve for Ohio.

If you develop COVID-19 symptoms, call your health care provider first. If your symptoms are mild, stay at home and treat yourself. If symptoms become severe seek medical attention.

This is a rapidly evolving situation. MCPH continues to work diligently with Ohio Department of Health and local partners to address the situation.
