Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Outbreak Update

Miami County - Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 outbreak in Miami County.

As of today, Tuesday, March 24, 2020 there are no new cases of COVID-19 being reported in Miami County. There are currently 23 positive cases in Miami County, 22 are associated with Koester Pavilion & Springmeade Heath Center.

Miami County Public Health has received a lot of questions around Governor DeWine & Dr. Acton's most recent Stay-at-Home order. MCPH is working with organizations to help provide a more clear understanding of what is considered "essential business". Companies that remain open need to follow the Governor & Dr. Acton's recommendations on social distancing and guidance on monitoring employee health.
