Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

Miami County - Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 in Miami County.

As of today, Wednesday, April 29, 2020, Miami County is reporting 138 positive COVID-19 cases and 27 deaths due to COVID-19, in Miami County. The case age range is less than 1 year old to 96 years old, with 83 females & 55 males.

On May 1st, Ohio will begin the transition to reopen Ohio businesses. The Responsible Restart Ohio rollout schedule is as follows:

May 1st: Dental Offices, Veterinary Offices & certain elective healthcare procedures

May 4th: Manufacturing, Distribution & Construction

May 12th: Consumer, Retail & Services

Businesses that will remain closed include: schools, dine-on restaurants & bars, personal appearance & beauty businesses, older adult day care services & senior centers, adult support or vocational habilitation services in group settings, entertainment, recreation and gyms.
