## Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

**Miami County -** Miami County Public Health is issuing an update on the COVID-19 in Miami County.

As of today, Monday, March 30, 2020, Miami County is reporting the 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> death associated with COVID-19. The individuals were an 85 year old male, resident of Springmeade Health Center and an 85 year old female, resident of Koester Pavilion. Ohio Department of Health is reporting 46 positive COVID-19 cases in Miami County, with 16 hospitalizations. Of the 46 cases, 22 are female and 24 are male.

The distance learning and Closure for Ohio K-12 Schools order has been extended through May 1, 2020. It is important that everyone in the community continue to following the social distancing guidelines and Stay-At-Home. This will slow the spread of the virus and will flatten the curve for Ohio.

If you develop COVID-19 symptoms, call your health care provider first. If your symptoms are mild, stay at home and treat yourself. If symptoms become severe seek medical attention.

As this situation continues to change, MCPH is working diligently to provide the community with the most current information.
