Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

Miami County- Miami County remains at a Red #3 COVID-19 risk level. This Red #3 COVID-19 Risk Level is due to Miami County meeting the criteria for four of the seven Alert Indicators and continues to be listed as a High Incidence Area:

- 50+ cases /100,000 population within last two weeks
- New Case Trajectory increase over a 5-day period
- More than 50% of new cases are from non-congregate care living
- COVID-like Out-Patient Visit Trajectory increase over a 5-day period

This risk level indicates very high exposure and spread of COVID-19. It is advised that community members limit activities as much as possible and follow all current health orders. Limit events over ten people and non-essential activities as much as possible. Miami County will stay at a Red level #3 until we are no longer in the high incidence category.

Since March 12th, 2021, there have been 179 new cases which brings the total number of COVID-19 cases in Miami County to 10,281, 528 hospitalizations, and 9,832 presumed recovered.

According to the Ohio Department of Health, in Miami County, nearly 25% of the population has received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine. To continue these efforts, MCPH will be hosting multiple COVID-19 Vaccine clinics throughout the county next week. Everyone 16 years or older is now eligible for the Pfizer vaccine and 18 years and older for the Moderna vaccine. MCPH currently has over 1,000 daytime, evening, and weekend vaccine appointments available for the upcoming clinics.
