**Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update**

**Miami County-** Miami County remains at an Orange #2 COVID-19 risk level. This is due to Miami County meeting criteria for two of the seven Alert Indicators. The indicators met include:

- 50+ cases /100,000 population within last two weeks
- More than 50% of new cases are from non-congregate care living

The Orange #2 COVID-19 Risk level indicates increased exposure and spread of COVID-19. Community members are advised to exercise a high degree of caution. Since April 30th, 2021, there have been 77 new COVID-19 cases which brings the total number of cases in Miami County to 10,706, with 573 hospitalizations, 220 deaths, and 10,362 presumed recovered.

Next week, Miami County Public Health will be hosting multiple COVID-19 vaccine clinics located at the Troy Business Park at 880 Arthur Dr. in Troy. The clinics will offer the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines to anyone 18 and older, and the Pfizer vaccine for those 12 and older.

Governor DeWine has announced incentives for Ohioans to get their COVID Shot. Ohioans under the age of 18 who are eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine will be entered into a drawing for a four-year full scholarship to any of Ohio's state colleges and universities, including full tuition, room, and board. Ohioans aged 18 and older will be entered into a weekly drawing with a prize of up to \$1 million. A total of five weekly drawings for each prize will take place, with the first winners being announced on May 26th. Winners must have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine by the date of the respective drawing.
