## Miami County Public Health COVID-19 Update

**Miami County**- From June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021, to June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021, there have been 35 new COVID-19 cases. As of June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021, the total number of cases in Miami County was 10850, with 588 hospitalizations, 225 deaths, and 10,561 presumed recovered.

This week, Miami County Public Health (MCPH) will be hosting multiple COVID-19 vaccine clinics located at the Troy Business Park at 880 Arthur Dr. in Troy and a drive-thru clinic at the Upper Valley Career Center. The clinics will offer the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines to anyone 18 and older and Pfizer vaccine to those 12 years and older. MCPH will be partnering with Shared Harvest Foodbank to offer a drive-thru clinic this Saturday June 26, 2021, at their drive-thru food distribution event located at the Upper Valley Career Center. MCPH will be offering the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine for those 18 years or older from 8:00am-11:00am. We will also be offering \$10 Walmart gift cards to the first 30 shots given.
