Public Notice of Hearing for Proposed Miami County Public Health 2026 Household Sewage Treatment System Fees

On September 25, 2025, the Miami County Board of Health conducted the first of three readings to establish fees in the Household Sewage Treatment System program. In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code chapter 3709.09, the local licensor shall give written notice to all establishments that may be affected by the change in fees.
